STEP 1 Introduction



Note that this guide is intended for all ages and experience levels. However, previous experience with putting socks on is **highly recommended**.



Note: The style of print might differ as we offer more versions.



To ensure optimal stability and to prevent any life-threatening situations during this process, we recommend sitting down. PRUSA Research is not liable for any injuries caused by putting on PRUSA Socks.



With that said, we are happy to take full responsibility when someone compliments you on your fashion choice.



Our research confirmed that starting with one sock and fully putting it on, then moving on to the other sock, is by far the best way to go about this process.

STEP 2 Putting the socks on



CAUTION: If you decide to take the standing approach to applying socks, **ensure you're steady enough to lift a foot without losing your balance.**

- Start by rolling the sock. Stick your thumbs in the sock's input hole and roll the sock with your fingers along the outer perimeter until you reach the end.
- Once the sock is rolled up, proceed to insert your toes. Push the rest of your foot in until you reach the end.
- Pull the sock up while gently pushing your foot further in.
- Ensure that the black heel part of the sock **fully covers the heel part** of your foot.

STEP 3 Setting of convenience



- ◆ You can adjust the style and pull the sock as high up as you want.
- ⚠ **It's crucial to ensure that the PRUSA logo is visible for extra street cred.**
- ◆ Well done.

STEP 4 Socks maintenance



- ⚠ **To keep your PRUSA socks looking good for as long as possible, make sure not to wash them rolled up in each other.**
- ◆ Unravel the socks and stretch them out before adding them to your laundry basket.
- ⓘ We recommend washing PRUSA socks on 30°C (86°F) or 40°C (104°F) to prevent shrinkage and damage to the material.
