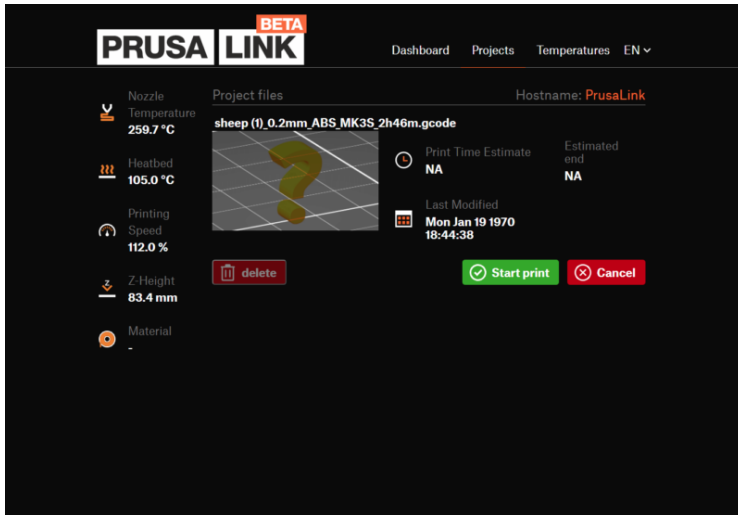

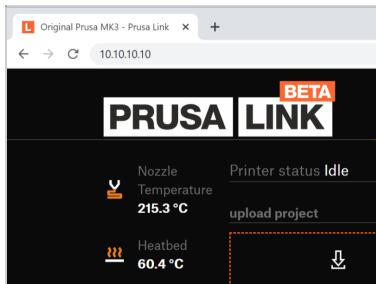

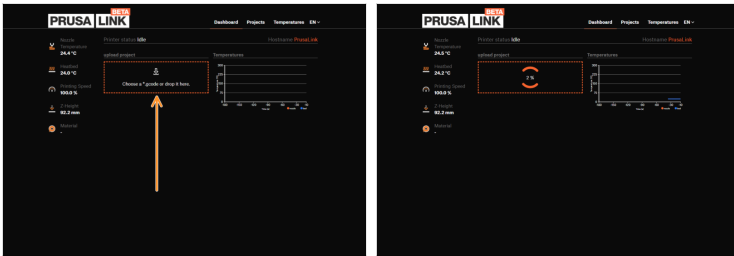
STEP 1 Opening up PrusaLink

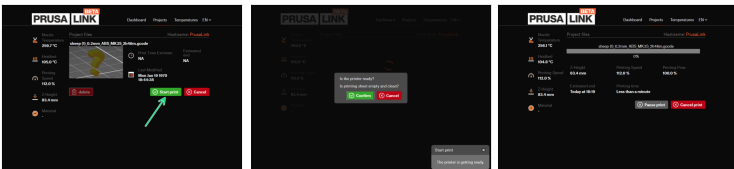
-  Check the printer physically if it's on and ready to print.
-  Insert the **IP Address** of your printer into a web browser to open up PrusaLink.
-  **PrusaLink** site will open up. **Log in.**
-  Remember, in case of MK3/S/+, there is the printer-specific PrusaLink Login. This is not your Prusa Account.
-  In order to send files to PrusaLink directly, you have to be connected to the same local network as the printer. The other way is to use VPN.

STEP 2 Uploading a file to PrusaLink



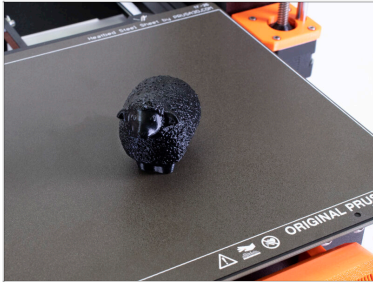
- 🟠 Select or drop in a G-Code file.
- ⬛ PrusaLink will start uploading the file.

STEP 3 Starting the print



- ⬛ Make sure the printer is ready to print.
- ⬛ Visit the **Projects** tab.
- 🟢 In the desired project file, select **Start Print**
- ⬛ Verify the printer is ready to print. Check that the print sheet is clean, degreased and empty. Your printer will start printing after you hit the **Confirm** button.

STEP 4 You are done!
